A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the regulation of composting in certain counties;
- 3 authorizing a civil penalty.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 364, Health and Safety
- 6 Code, is amended by adding Section 364.020 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 364.020. DEPOSIT OF CERTAIN FOOD WASTE FOR COMPOSTING
- 8 IN CERTAIN COUNTIES PROHIBITED. (a) In this section:
- 9 (1) "Commercial food waste composting ordinance"
- 10 means a municipal ordinance that requires a multifamily residential
- 11 property, a business holding a food permit, or another business
- 12 owner to divert food waste from disposal in a landfill.
- 13 (2) "Composting facility" means a facility that
- 14 composts source-separated yard trimmings, clean wood material,
- 15 vegetative material, paper, manure, meat, fish, dead animal
- 16 carcasses, dairy materials, or meat and vegetable oils and greases
- 17 from a municipal, commercial, or institutional source.
- (b) Except as provided by Subsection (e), a person may not
- 19 deposit at a composting facility located in a county that does not
- 20 contain a municipality with a commercial food waste composting
- 21 ordinance food waste that is:
- 22 (1) collected for composting in a municipality that
- 23 has a commercial food waste composting ordinance; and
- 24 (2) subject to such an ordinance.

- 1 (c) A person is liable for a civil penalty of \$1,000 for each
- 2 violation of Subsection (b).
- 3 (d) The attorney general may bring an action in a court of
- 4 competent jurisdiction to recover the civil penalty imposed under
- 5 this section.
- 6 (e) This section does not apply to:
- 7 (1) an agricultural operation as defined by Section
- 8 251.002, Agriculture Code;
- 9 (2) a composting facility located in a county
- 10 described by Subsection (b) if the commissioners court of the
- 11 county by resolution or order authorizes the deposit of food waste
- 12 subject to a commercial food waste composting ordinance at the
- 13 <u>facili</u>ty; or
- 14 (3) a composting facility that:
- (A) is authorized to operate under a valid
- 16 <u>notification issued by the commission on or before January 1, 2025;</u>
- 17 and
- 18 (B) accepted food waste described by Subsection
- 19 (b) before January 1, 2025.
- 20 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
