## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to various matters pertaining to certain governmental

- 3 entities that operate port facilities.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter J, Chapter 441, Government Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 441.1681 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 441.1681. ELECTRONIC STORAGE OF CERTAIN LOCAL
- 8 GOVERNMENT RECORDS. (a) The port commission of a navigation
- 9 district or port authority or a board of trustees established under
- 10 Chapter 54, Transportation Code, may establish alternative storage
- 11 and retention standards and procedures for the records of the
- 12 navigation district, port authority, or board of trustees. The
- 13 <u>rules must establish:</u>
- 14 (1) a process for the port commission or board of
- 15 trustees to use the alternative storage standards and procedures;
- 16 (2) procedures for the conversion of hard copy
- 17 documents retained by the custodian of the navigation district,
- 18 port authority, or board of trustees to an electronic form and the
- 19 destruction of the hard copy documents; and
- 20 (3) standards for electronic record management and the
- 21 preservation of documents retained by the custodian of the
- 22 <u>navigation district, port authority, or board of trustees.</u>
- 23 (b) In establishing the standards and procedures under this
- 24 section, a port commission or board of trustees may not establish a

- 1 retention period that is shorter than a retention period required
- 2 under a state or federal law or court order.
- 3 SECTION 2. Section 2252.909(a), Government Code, as added
- 4 by Chapter 1008 (H.B. 2518), Acts of the 88th Legislature, Regular
- 5 Session, 2023, is amended to read as follows:
- 6 (a) In this section, "governmental entity" has the meaning
- 7 assigned by Section 2253.001, except that the term does not include
- 8 a:
- 9 (1) navigation district;
- 10 (2) port authority; or
- 11 (3) board of trustees established under Chapter 54,
- 12 Transportation Code.
- SECTION 3. Subchapter B, Chapter 5007, Special District
- 14 Local Laws Code, is amended by adding Section 5007.229 to read as
- 15 follows:
- Sec. 5007.229. CONTRACTS: CERTAIN PURCHASES.
- 17 Notwithstanding Section 60.403(a), Water Code, the port commission
- 18 may delegate authority to an authorized designated officer of the
- 19 port commission, the executive director of the authority, or an
- 20 authorized representative of the executive director to make routine
- 21 purchases or contracts in an amount not to exceed \$500,000.
- 22 SECTION 4. Section 54.005, Transportation Code, is amended
- 23 to read as follows:
- Sec. 54.005. APPLICABILITY OF OTHER LAW. (a) Except to the
- 25 extent that it conflicts or is inconsistent with this chapter,
- 26 Subchapter B, Chapter 1502, Government Code, applies to revenue
- 27 obligations issued under this chapter, and a municipality to which

- 1 this chapter applies has, with respect to a revenue obligation
- 2 issued under this chapter, each power granted by that subchapter.
- 3 (b) A qualifying interest is considered to be an interest in
- 4 property used as an aid or facility incidental to or useful in the
- 5 operation or development of a port or waterway or in aid of
- 6 <u>navigation-related commerce for purposes of Section 25.07, Tax</u>
- 7 Code, and the qualifying interest may not be listed in the name of
- 8 the owner of the qualifying interest in the appraisal records of the
- 9 appraisal district that appraises the property to which the
- 10 interest relates as provided by that section. To the extent of any
- 11 conflict with Section 25.07, Tax Code, this section controls with
- 12 respect to a qualifying interest.
- (c) For purposes of Subsection (b), "qualifying interest"

- 18 (B) a board; and
- 19 (2) established by a lease or other agreement

- 21 SECTION 5. Section 54.054, Transportation Code, is amended
- 22 by amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsections (c) and (d) to
- 23 read as follows:
- 24 (a) Except for routine purchases and contracts and as
- 25 otherwise provided by this chapter, the board may award a contract
- 26 involving the expenditure of funds in excess of the amount
- 27 applicable to an expenditure of funds by a municipality under

- 1 Section 252.021(a), Local Government Code, only by competitive
- 2 bidding.
- 3 (c) The board, an authorized designated officer of the
- 4 board, the general manager employed by the board, or an authorized
- 5 representative of the general manager may make routine purchases or
- 6 contracts in an amount not to exceed \$50,000. The board may
- 7 delegate authority to an authorized designated officer of the
- 8 board, the general manager employed by the board, or an authorized
- 9 representative of the general manager to make routine purchases or
- 10 contracts under this section in an amount not to exceed \$500,000.
- 11 <u>(d) Professional services shall be procured in accordance</u>
- 12 with Subchapter A, Chapter 2254, Government Code.
- SECTION 6. Subchapter Q, Chapter 60, Water Code, is amended
- 14 by adding Section 60.503 to read as follows:
- Sec. 60.503. CLOSED MEETINGS. Notwithstanding Section
- 16 551.103, Government Code, a port commission is not required to make
- 17 a recording of the proceedings of a closed meeting to deliberate
- 18 security measures, including cybersecurity measures, related to
- 19 the navigation district or port authority.
- 20 SECTION 7. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
