- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 508, Government Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 508.1143 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 508.1143. CERTAIN RESTRICTIONS ON RELEASEE JOB
- 8 INTERVIEWS PROHIBITED. A parole officer may not:
- 9 <u>(1) limit the number of job interviews that a releasee</u>
- 10 may attend per day; or
- 11 (2) prohibit a releasee from visiting a premises,
- 12 facility, or location without specific approval for the visit by
- 13 the parole officer if the visit is for a job interview and the
- 14 releasee has previously been approved to visit the premises,
- 15 facility, or location for a related purpose.
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 17 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 18 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 19 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 20 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
