12	(b) A peace officer commissioned under this section may:
13	(1) administer this chapter;
14	(2) support fire-related operations or
15	<pre>investigations;</pre>
16	(3) enforce building-related codes, including codes
17	involving hazardous materials; and
18	(4) make recommendations involving building safety.
19	SECTION 2. Chapter 362, Local Government Code, is amended
20	by adding Section 362.006 to read as follows:
21	Sec. 362.006. ESTABLISHMENT OF CERTAIN LAW ENFORCEMENT
22	AGENCIES. A county may establish a law enforcement agency only if
23	authorized by the constitution or other law.
24	SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
