## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to increasing the criminal penalty for loading certain

3 overweight vehicles transporting hazardous materials at a weight

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
