- 7 SECTION 1. Section 2003.047(i), Government Code, is amended
- 8 to read as follows:
- 9 (i) The office and the commission jointly shall adopt rules
- 10 providing for certification to the commission of an issue that
- 11 involves an ultimate finding of compliance with or satisfaction of
- 12 a statutory standard the determination of which is committed to the
- 13 discretion or judgment of the commission by law. Each agency shall
- 14 publish the jointly adopted rules. The rules must:
- 15 (1) address, at a minimum, the issues that are
- 16 appropriate for certification and the procedure to be used in
- 17 certifying the issue; and
- (2) provide that any issue raised by a party relating
- 19 to the scope of discovery under Subsection (g) shall be promptly
- 20 certified by the administrative law judge to the commission. [Each
- 21 agency shall publish the jointly adopted rules.
- 22 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 23 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 24 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this

- 1 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 2 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
