- 2 relating to the revocation of a driver's license for failure to pay
 3 a civil penalty imposed by the Texas Ethics Commission.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter F, Chapter 571, Government Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 571.178 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 571.178. REVOCATION OF DRIVER'S LICENSE. If a person
- 8 does not pay a civil penalty imposed by the commission within 60
- 9 days of the date the commission imposed the civil penalty, and the
- 10 civil penalty has not otherwise been waived under this subchapter,
- 11 the commission shall notify the Texas Department of Public Safety
- 12 and request that the department revoke the person's driver's
- 13 license.

- SECTION 2. Section 521.294, Transportation Code, is amended
- 15 to read as follows:
- 16 Sec. 521.294. DEPARTMENT'S DETERMINATION FOR LICENSE
- 17 REVOCATION. The department shall revoke the person's license if
- 18 the department:
- 19 (1) determines that the person:
- 20 $\underline{\text{(A)}}$ [\frac{\lambda}{1}\right] is incapable of safely operating a
- 21 motor vehicle;
- (B) $\left[\frac{(2)}{2}\right]$ has not complied with the terms of a
- 23 citation issued by a jurisdiction that is a party to the Nonresident
- 24 Violator Compact of 1977 for a traffic violation to which that

- 1 compact applies;
- 2 (C) $[\frac{(3)}{(3)}]$ has failed to provide medical records
- 3 or has failed to undergo medical or other examinations as required
- 4 by a panel of the medical advisory board;
- 5 (D) $\left[\frac{4}{1}\right]$ has failed to pass an examination
- 6 required by the director under this chapter; or
- 7 $\underline{\text{(E)}}$ [\(\frac{(5)}{}\)] has committed an offense in another
- 8 state or Canadian province that, if committed in this state, would
- 9 be grounds for revocation; or
- 10 (2) is notified by the Texas Ethics Commission in
- 11 accordance with Section 571.178, Government Code, that the person
- 12 has not paid a civil penalty imposed by the commission within 60
- 13 days following the date the civil penalty was imposed.
- 14 SECTION 3. Section 521.312(c), Transportation Code, is
- 15 amended to read as follows:
- 16 (c) The department may not reinstate a license revoked under
- 17 Section 521.294(1)(E) [521.294(5)] until the court that filed the
- 18 report for which the license was revoked files an additional report
- 19 on final disposition of the case.
- SECTION 4. Section 571.178, Government Code, as added by
- 21 this Act, applies only to the payment of a civil penalty or fine
- 22 imposed by the Texas Ethics Commission on or after the effective
- 23 date of this Act. The payment of a civil penalty or fine imposed by
- 24 the Texas Ethics Commission before the effective date of this Act is
- 25 governed by the law in effect on the date the penalty or fine was
- 26 imposed, and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 27 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
