- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 180, Local Government Code, is amended
- 6 by adding Section 180.011 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 180.011. LIMITATION ON SEVERANCE PAY FOR EXECUTIVE
- 8 EMPLOYEES. (a) In this section:
- 9 (1) "Misconduct" means an act or omission by an
- 10 employee of a political subdivision in the performance of the
- 11 employee's duties that the governing body of the political
- 12 subdivision determines to be misconduct. The term includes any
- 13 finding of criminal conduct.
- 14 (2) "Severance pay" means dismissal or separation
- 15 income paid on termination of the employment of an employee that is
- 16 in addition to the employee's usual earnings from the employer at
- 17 the time of termination.
- 18 (b) A person is an executive employee of a political
- 19 subdivision for purposes of this section if the person is:
- 20 <u>(1) a chief executive officer of a political</u>
- 21 subdivision other than a school district;
- 22 (2) an agency or department head; or
- 23 (3) the superintendent of a school district or the
- 24 chief executive officer of an open-enrollment charter school.

- 1 (c) A political subdivision that enters into an employment
- 2 agreement, or renewal or renegotiation of an existing employment
- 3 agreement, that contains a provision for severance pay with an
- 4 executive employee must include:
- 5 (1) a requirement that severance pay that is paid from
- 6 tax revenue may not exceed the amount of compensation, at the rate
- 7 at the termination of employment, the executive employee would have
- 8 been paid for 20 weeks, excluding paid time off or accrued vacation
- 9 leave; and
- 10 (2) a prohibition of the provision of severance pay
- 11 when the executive employee is terminated for misconduct.
- 12 (d) A political subdivision shall post each severance
- 13 agreement in a prominent place on the political subdivision's
- 14 Internet website.
- 15 (e) This subsection applies to an action brought against a
- 16 political subdivision by an executive employee of the political
- 17 subdivision arising from the termination of the person's
- 18 employment. A court may not issue a writ of execution or mandamus
- 19 in connection with a judgment in the action if the judgment does not
- 20 comply with this section.
- 21 SECTION 2. Section 180.011, Local Government Code, as added
- 22 by this Act, applies only to an employment agreement entered into or
- 23 an action filed on or after the effective date of this Act.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
