- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 1701, Occupations Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 1701.171 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 1701.171. STUDY AND REPORT. (a) The commission shall
- 8 study incidents of racial profiling by peace officers in this state
- 9 and, not later than December 1, 2026, report to the legislature
- 10 recommendations on model policies that may be adopted by a law
- 11 enforcement agency that the commission believes would
- 12 substantially reduce or eliminate incidents of racial profiling by
- 13 the peace officers of the law enforcement agency.
- 14 (b) To the extent practicable, the commission shall use the
- 15 incident-based data submitted to the commission under Article
- 16 2B.0055, Code of Criminal Procedure, in the study required by
- 17 Subsection (a).
- 18 <u>(c) This section expires January 1, 2027.</u>
- 19 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
