A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to the creation of the Texas Advanced Research Institute.
3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Subtitle F, Title 4, Government Code, is amended
5	by adding Chapter 483 to read as follows:
6	CHAPTER 483. TEXAS ADVANCED RESEARCH INSTITUTE
7	Sec. 483.001. DEFINITIONS. In this chapter:
8	(1) "Council" means the governing council of the
9	institute.
10	(2) "Institute" means the Texas Advanced Research
11	Institute.
12	Sec. 483.002. PURPOSES. The Texas Advanced Research
13	Institute is established in the office of the governor to:
14	(1) promote advanced research efforts in all
15	disciplines, including:
16	
	(A) energy;
17	(B) medicine; and
18	(C) biotechnology;
19	(2) attract, create, or expand research capabilities
20	of public or private institutions of higher education and other
21	<pre>public or private entities that will promote a substantial increase</pre>
22	in advanced research and development and in the creation of
23	inventions and patents in this state;
24	(3) ensure that this state invests and receives a

- 1 return on investment in advanced research and development
- 2 commensurate with the size and influence of this state's economy;
- 3 and
- 4 (4) serve as an intermediary between institutions of
- 5 higher education, the private sector, and other stakeholders to
- 6 develop the workforce of this state and equip that workforce with
- 7 skills and credentials for the jobs and professions of the future,
- 8 including technical skills.
- 9 Sec. 483.003. SUNSET PROVISION. The Texas Advanced
- 10 Research Institute is subject to Chapter 325 (Texas Sunset Act).
- 11 Unless continued in existence as provided by that chapter, the
- 12 institute is abolished and this chapter expires September 1, 2037.
- Sec. 483.004. POWERS AND DUTIES. (a) The institute:
- 14 (1) may make grants to provide funding to public or
- 15 private persons to conduct research and development with the
- 16 objective of advancing knowledge, creating intellectual property,
- 17 and identifying commercial opportunities to monetize the products
- 18 resulting from advanced research and development;
- 19 (2) shall coordinate with participating public and
- 20 private persons to develop the Texas Advanced Research Plan;
- 21 (3) may support institutions of higher education,
- 22 advanced research facilities, and collaborations in this state in
- 23 all stages in the process of conducting and exploiting advanced
- 24 research and development;
- 25 (4) may establish the appropriate standards and
- 26 oversight bodies to ensure the proper use of funds authorized under
- 27 this chapter for advanced research and development;

- 1 (5) shall continuously monitor contracts and
- 2 agreements authorized by this chapter and ensure that each grant
- 3 recipient complies with the terms and conditions of the grant
- 4 contract;
- 5 (6) shall ensure that all grant proposals comply with
- 6 this chapter and rules adopted under this chapter before the
- 7 proposals are granted approval; and
- 8 (7) shall establish procedures to document that the
- 9 institute, its employees, and council members appointed under this
- 10 chapter comply with all laws governing the academic peer review
- 11 process and conflicts of interest where applicable.
- 12 (b) The institute shall implement the Texas Advanced
- 13 Research Plan and continually monitor and revise the plan as
- 14 necessary.
- Sec. 483.005. LEADERSHIP, STAFF, AND RESOURCES. (a) The
- 16 institute is governed by a council of nine members appointed by the
- 17 governor.
- 18 (b) Members of the council serve staggered six-year terms
- 19 with one-third of the members' terms expiring on February 1 of each
- 20 odd-numbered year.
- 21 <u>(c) The governor shall designate a member as the president</u>
- 22 of the council to serve in that capacity at the pleasure of the
- 23 governor.
- 24 (d) The office of the governor shall provide the institute
- 25 with necessary staff and resources to perform the institute's
- 26 duties under this chapter.
- Sec. 483.006. DUTIES OF COUNCIL. (a) The council shall

- 1 select the recipients of any grants awarded by the institute.
- 2 (b) The council may conduct surveys, research, or
- 3 investigations for the purposes of the institute.
- 4 Sec. 483.007. MEETINGS. The council shall meet at least
- 5 once each year at the call of the president.
- 6 Sec. 483.008. FUNDING. (a) The institute may receive
- 7 state-appropriated funds for the purpose of supporting the
- 8 activities of the institute.
- 9 (b) The institute may solicit, accept, and use gifts,
- 10 grants, and donations from public and private sources for the
- 11 purposes of this chapter, subject only to limitations contained in
- 12 the gifts, grants, or donations.
- (c) The institute may receive funding in the form of
- 14 royalties, license fees, and profits resulting from inventions,
- 15 discoveries, and products developed by or in partnership with, or
- 16 coordinated through, the institute.
- 17 SECTION 2. In appointing the initial members of the council
- 18 of the Texas Advanced Research Institute, the governor shall
- 19 appoint three members for terms expiring February 1, 2027, three
- 20 members for terms expiring February 1, 2029, and three members for
- 21 terms expiring February 1, 2031.
- 22 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
