## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to the process of establishing speed limits on a highway or
- 3 road near a prekindergarten.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 545.355(b), Transportation Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (b) The commissioners court of a county may declare a lower
- 8 speed limit of not less than:
- 9 (1) 30 miles per hour on a county road or highway to
- 10 which this section applies, if the commissioners court determines
- 11 that the prima facie speed limit on the road or highway is
- 12 unreasonable or unsafe; or
- 13 (2) 20 miles per hour:
- 14 (A) in a residence district, unless the roadway
- 15 has been designated as a major thoroughfare by a city planning
- 16 commission; or
- 17 (B) on a county road or highway to which this
- 18 section applies that is located within 500 feet of  $\underline{a}$
- 19 prekindergarten, an elementary, secondary, or open-enrollment
- 20 charter  $school_{\underline{\prime}}$  or an institution of higher education, if approved
- 21 under Section 545.357.
- 22 SECTION 2. Sections 545.357(a), (b), (c), (d), and (e),
- 23 Transportation Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 24 (a) The governing body of a municipality in which a

- 1 prekindergarten, a public or private elementary or secondary
- 2 school, an open-enrollment charter school, or an institution of
- 3 higher education is located shall, on request of the operator of a
- 4 prekindergarten or the governing body of a school or institution of
- 5 higher education, hold a public hearing at least once each calendar
- 6 year to consider prima facie speed limits on a highway in the
- 7 municipality, including a highway of the state highway system, near
- 8 the prekindergarten, school, or institution of higher education.
- 9 (b) If a county road outside the state highway system is
- 10 located within 500 feet of a prekindergarten, a public or private
- 11 elementary or secondary school, an open-enrollment charter school,
- 12 or an institution of higher education that is not in a municipality,
- 13 the commissioners court of the county, on request of the operator of
- 14 a prekindergarten or the governing body of a school or institution
- 15 of higher education, shall hold a public hearing at least once each
- 16 calendar year to consider the prima facie speed limit on the road
- 17 near the prekindergarten, school, or institution of higher
- 18 education.
- 19 (c) A municipal governing body or commissioners court, on
- 20 request of the operator of a prekindergarten or the governing body
- 21 of a school or institution of higher education, may hold one public
- 22 hearing for all prekindergartens, public and private elementary and
- 23 secondary schools, open-enrollment charter schools, and
- 24 institutions of higher education in its jurisdiction.
- 25 (d) The Texas Transportation Commission, on request of the
- 26 operator of a prekindergarten or the governing body of a school or
- 27 institution of higher education, shall hold a public hearing at

- 1 least once each calendar year to consider prima facie speed limits
- 2 on highways in the state highway system that are near
- 3 prekindergartens, public or private elementary or secondary
- 4 schools, open-enrollment charter schools, or institutions of
- 5 higher education.
- 6 (e) On request of the operator of a prekindergarten or the
- 7 governing body of a school or institution of higher education
- 8 following a public hearing held under this section, the
- 9 commissioners court, municipal governing body, or Texas
- 10 Transportation Commission, as applicable, shall conduct an
- 11 engineering and traffic investigation for the highway or road that
- 12 is the subject of the request. On review of the results of the
- 13 investigation, the commissioners court, municipal governing body,
- 14 or Texas Transportation Commission has the same authority and
- 15 discretion to alter prima facie speed limits as provided by Section
- 16 545.353, 545.355, or 545.356, as applicable. Following each public
- 17 hearing held under this section, the operator of a prekindergarten
- 18 or the governing body of a school or institution of higher education
- 19 may make only one request under this subsection for an engineering
- 20 and traffic investigation.
- 21 SECTION 3. Section 545.357(f), Transportation Code, is
- 22 amended by adding Subdivision (4) to read as follows:
- 23 (4) "Prekindergarten" means a facility that primarily
- 24 provides prekindergarten services.
- 25 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
