## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to a maternal health training program for certain health
3	care providers.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subtitle B, Title 2, Health and Safety Code, is
6	amended by adding Chapter 34A to read as follows:
7	CHAPTER 34A. MATERNAL HEALTH TRAINING PROGRAM FOR HEALTH CARE
8	PROVIDERS
9	Sec. 34A.001. DEFINITIONS. In this chapter:
10	(1) "Health care provider" and "maternal morbidity'
11	have the meanings assigned by Section 34.001.
12	(2) "Review committee" means the Texas Maternal
13	Mortality and Morbidity Review Committee established under Chapter
14	<u>34.</u>
15	(3) "TexasAIM" means the program established by the
16	department in collaboration with the Alliance for Innovation or
17	Maternal Health and the Texas Hospital Association to assist health
18	care providers with implementing maternal safety projects and
19	decreasing incidents of preventable maternal death and severe
20	maternal morbidity by applying best practices for maternal safety
21	and improving maternal health care.
22	(4) "Training program" means the maternal health
23	training program established under Section 34A.002.

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Sec. 34A.002. MATERNAL HEALTH TRAINING PROGRAM. (a) The

- 1 department shall develop and implement a training program for
- 2 health care providers providing health care services to maternal
- 3 patients in this state.
- 4 (b) The training program must ensure health care providers
- 5 providing health care services to maternal patients are equipped to
- 6 deliver consistent, superior health care services.
- 7 <u>(c) The department shall collaborate with the review</u>
- 8 committee to establish the training program curriculum. The
- 9 training program curriculum must include:
- 10 (1) evidence-based protocols for obstetric
- 11 emergencies;
- 12 (2) TexasAIM maternal safety best practices for
- 13 specific maternal and postpartum conditions;
- 14 (3) maternal safety simulations; and
- 15 (4) other information the review committee recommends
- 16 regarding best practices for reducing maternal mortality and
- 17 morbidity rates.
- 18 (d) The executive commissioner by rule shall require health
- 19 care providers providing health care services to maternal patients
- 20 to participate in the training program.
- 21 <u>Sec. 34A.003. RULES. The executive commissioner shall</u>
- 22 adopt rules as necessary to establish and implement the training
- 23 program under this chapter, including rules regarding monitoring
- 24 health care provider compliance.
- 25 SECTION 2. As soon as practicable after the effective date
- 26 of this Act, the executive commissioner of the Health and Human
- 27 Services Commission shall adopt the rules required by Chapter 34A,

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- 1 Health and Safety Code, as added by this Act.
- 2 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
