- 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 153, Occupations Code, is
- 7 amended by adding Section 153.053 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 153.053. SURCHARGE TO ADMINISTER TEXAS PHYSICIAN
- 9 HEALTH PROGRAM. (a) The board shall collect an additional
- 10 surcharge not to exceed \$15 for each of the following fees:
- 11 (1) first registration permit; and
- 12 (2) renewal of a registration permit.
- 13 (b) The board shall deposit each surcharge collected under
- 14 this section to the credit of the Texas physician health program
- 15 account. The Texas physician health program account is a special
- 16 account in the general revenue fund. Money in the special account
- 17 shall be appropriated only to the board to pay for administration of
- 18 the Texas Physician Health Program under Chapter 167, including
- 19 paying for an initial evaluation by the program's medical director
- 20 or the director's designee. Money in the special account may not be
- 21 used to pay for program participant costs incurred for monitoring
- 22 or for a program participant's own medical costs, including any
- 23 further required evaluations, primary treatment, or continuing
- 24 care.
- 25 (c) The board is authorized to collect the surcharge

- 4 SECTION 2. Subchapter B, Chapter 153, Occupations Code, is
- 5 amended by adding Section 153.055 to read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 153.055. SURCHARGE FOR CERTAIN SEARCHES RELATED TO
- 7 LICENSE STATUS. (a) The board shall set and collect an additional
- 8 surcharge to cover the cost of administering a continuous query on
- 9 the National Practitioner Data Bank as required by Section
- 10 154.006(m). The surcharge shall be collected from each license
- 11 holder for:
- 12 (1) issuance of a first registration permit; and
- 13 (2) renewal of a registration permit.
- 14 (b) The board shall deposit each surcharge collected under
- 15 this section to the credit of the public assurance account
- 16 described by Section 153.0535(b).
- 17 <u>(c) The board is authorized to collect the surcharge</u>
- 18 established in (a) for all individuals licensed and regulated by
- 19 the board including all advisory boards and committees under this
- 20 title.
- 21 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 22 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 23 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 24 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 25 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
