## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to coverage for maternal depression screenings under
- 3 Medicaid and the child health plan program.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 62.1511(b), Health and Safety Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (b) The covered services under the child health plan must
- 8 include <u>up to four</u> [a] maternal depression <u>screenings</u> [screening]
- 9 for an enrollee's mother, regardless of whether the mother is also
- 10 an enrollee, that are [is] performed during a covered well-child or
- 11 other office visit for the enrollee that occurs before the
- 12 enrollee's first birthday.
- SECTION 2. Section 32.0561(b), Human Resources Code, is
- 14 amended to read as follows:
- 15 (b) The commission shall provide medical assistance
- 16 reimbursement for <u>up to four</u> [a] maternal depression <u>screenings</u>
- 17 [screening] for a recipient's mother, regardless of whether the
- 18 mother is also a recipient, that  $\underline{are}$  [ $\underline{is}$ ] performed during a covered
- 19 examination for the recipient under the Texas Health Steps
- 20 Comprehensive Care Program that occurs before the recipient's first
- 21 birthday.
- 22 SECTION 3. If before implementing any provision of this Act
- 23 a state agency determines that a waiver or authorization from a
- 24 federal agency is necessary for implementation of that provision,

- 1 the agency affected by the provision shall request the waiver or
- 2 authorization and may delay implementing that provision until the
- 3 waiver or authorization is granted.
- 4 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
