- 8 who has executed a bond in an amount equal to the amount required
- 9 for the district treasurer to sign an instrument to disburse
- 10 district funds. An expenditure of more than \$50,000 [\$2,000] may
- 11 not be paid unless the expenditure is presented to the board and the
- 12 board approves the expenditure.
- 13 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 14 to a purchase made on or after the effective date of this Act. A
- 15 purchase made before the effective date of this Act is governed by
- 16 the law as it existed immediately before the effective date of this
- 17 Act, and that law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
