## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 51.331(b), Education Code, is amended by
- 7 adding Subdivision (3) to read as follows:
- 8 <u>(3) "Student" means a student who enrolls at an</u>
- 9 institution of higher education in a course or program of study
- 10 leading to a certificate, degree, or other undergraduate credential
- 11 or a dual credit course.
- 12 SECTION 2. Section 51.338(b), Education Code, is amended to
- 13 read as follows:
- 14 (b) A student who has achieved a score set by the board on
- 15 the PSAT, PreACT, SAT, or ACT is exempt from the requirements of
- 16 this subchapter. An exemption under this subsection is effective
- 17 for the five-year period following the date a student takes the test
- 18 and achieves the standard set by the board.
- 19 SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act applies
- 20 beginning with the assessment of entering undergraduate students at
- 21 public institutions of higher education for the 2025 fall semester.
- 22 The assessment of an entering undergraduate student for an academic
- 23 term before that semester is governed by the law in effect before
- 24 the effective date of this Act, and that law is continued in effect

- 2 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 3 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 4 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 5 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 6 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
