3	including the statute of limitations for certain fraud offenses.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Article 12.01, Code of Criminal Procedure, as
6	amended by Chapters 93 (S.B. 1527), 118 (H.B. 467), 127 (H.B. 1207),
7	422 (H.B. 1769), 520 (H.B. 3025), 689 (H.B. 1506), 704 (H.B. 2019),
8	709 (H.B. 2190), 768 (H.B. 4595), 830 (H.B. 2187), 885 (H.B. 4635),
9	and 1041 (S.B. 129), Acts of the 88th Legislature, Regular Session,
10	2023, is reenacted and amended to read as follows:
11	Art. 12.01. FELONIES. Except as provided in Articles
12	12.015 and 12.03, felony indictments may be presented within these
13	limits, and not afterward:
14	(1) no limitation:
15	(A) murder and manslaughter;
16	(B) sexual assault under Section 22.011(a)(2),
17	Penal Code, or aggravated sexual assault under Section
18	22.021(a)(1)(B), Penal Code;
19	(C) sexual assault, if:
20	(i) during the investigation of the offense
21	biological matter is collected and the matter:
22	(a) has not yet been subjected to
23	forensic DNA testing; or
24	(b) has been subjected to forensic DNA

- 16 (H) continuous trafficking of persons under
- 17 Section 20A.03, Penal Code;
- 18 (I) compelling prostitution under Section

- 5 (8) $\left[\frac{(7)}{(7)}\right]$ ten years from the date the offense was
- 6 discovered: trafficking of a disabled individual under Section
- 7 20A.02(a)(5) or (6), Penal Code;
- 8 (9) $[\frac{(8)}{(8)}]$ two years from the date the offense was
- 9 discovered: sexual assault punishable as a state jail felony under
- 10 Section 22.011(f)(2), Penal Code; or
- 11 (10) (49) three years from the date of the commission
- 12 of the offense: all other felonies.
- SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act does not apply
- 14 to an offense if the prosecution of that offense becomes barred by
- 15 limitation before the effective date of this Act. The prosecution
- 16 of that offense remains barred as if this Act had not taken effect.
- 17 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
