## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to requiring public schools to provide to certain parents
3	notice regarding certain incidents and risks related to the
4	parent's child and suicide prevention materials.
5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Section 37.0832, Education Code, is amended by
7	adding Subsections (c-2) and (c-3) to read as follows:
8	(c-2) The procedure for providing notice to a parent or
9	guardian of an alleged victim of an incident of bullying under
10	Subsection (c)(4) must include requirements to:
11	(1) maintain a record that verifies the parent or
12	guardian was notified of the incident; and
13	(2) provide the parent or guardian with:
14	(A) suicide prevention materials; and
15	(B) information on ways to limit the student's
16	access to means of committing suicide, including a firearm or
17	medication.
18	(c-3) The agency, in coordination with the Health and Human
19	Services Commission, shall select the materials and information
20	described by Subsection (c-2)(2).
21	SECTION 2. Section 38.351, Education Code, is amended by
22	adding Subsections (e-1) and (e-2) to read as follows:
23	(e-1) The board of trustees of a school district or the
24	governing body of an open-enrollment charter school shall adopt a

- 1 policy that establishes a procedure for providing notice in
- 2 addition to any notice provided in accordance with Subsection
- 3 (e)(3) to a parent or guardian of a student who is identified as at
- 4 risk of suicide. The procedure must include requirements to:
- 5 (1) maintain a record that verifies the parent or
- 6 guardian was notified regarding the risk; and
- 7 (2) provide the parent or guardian with:
- 8 (A) suicide prevention materials; and
- 9 (B) information on ways to limit the student's
- 10 access to means of committing suicide, including a firearm or
- 11 medication.
- 12 <u>(e-2)</u> The agency, in coordination with the Health and Human
- 13 Services Commission, shall select the materials and information
- 14 described by Subsection (e-1)(2).
- SECTION 3. This Act applies beginning with the 2025-2026
- 16 school year.
- 17 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 18 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 19 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 20 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 21 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
