- 2 relating to air quality permits for certain cement kilns.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 382, Health and Safety
- 5 Code, is amended by adding Section 382.0651 to read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 382.0651. CERTAIN LOCATIONS FOR OPERATING CERTAIN
- 7 CEMENT KILNS PROHIBITED. (a) The commission may not issue a permit
- 8 under Section 382.0518 to construct a facility that is a cement kiln
- 9 within 440 yards of a building in use as a school or place of worship
- 10 at the time the application for the permit is filed.
- 11 (b) The commission may not issue a federal operating permit
- 12 for a federal source that is a cement kiln classified as "major"
- 13 under any applicable permitting requirements of the federal Clean
- 14 Air Act (42 U.S.C. Section 7401 et seq.), or regulations adopted
- 15 under that Act, within 440 yards of a building in use as a school or
- 16 place of worship at the time the application for the permit is
- 17 filed.
- 18 <u>(c) The measurement of distance for the purposes of this</u>
- 19 section is the shortest distance between the facility or source and
- 20 the building in use as a school or place of worship.
- 21 SECTION 2. Section 382.0651, Health and Safety Code, as
- 22 added by this Act, applies only to a permit issued by the Texas
- 23 Commission on Environmental Quality on or after the effective date
- 24 of this Act.
