A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT relating to communications between the Texas Commission 2 3 Environmental Quality and the governor, the lieutenant governor, or 4 a member of the legislature. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter E, Chapter 5, Water Code, is amended 6 7 by adding Section 5.180 to read as follows: 8 Sec. 5.180. COMMUNICATIONS WITH CERTAIN GOVERNMENT OFFICIALS. (a) Notwithstanding any other law, the governor, the 9 10 lieutenant governor, or a member of the legislature may communicate in writing, including electronically, with a member of the 11 commission about an application for the issuance, amendment, 12 13 modification, or renewal of a permit, or for an authorization to use a permit, that is pending before the commission. A member of the 14 15 legislature may communicate under this section with the commission only about an application for a facility or proposed facility that 16 17 is located in the member's district. (b) A member of the commission shall receive a communication 18 described by Subsection (a). An employee of the commission that 19 receives a communication described by Subsection (a) shall transmit 20 the communication to the proper member of the commission and the 21 22 member shall receive the communication. The member of

commission is not required to be recused from the proceedings

related to the application discussed in the communication.

- 1 (c) The commission shall:
- 2 (1) include in the record of proceedings related to an
- 3 application a record of each communication received under this
- 4 section about the application; and
- 5 (2) provide for any party to the proceedings related
- 6 to an application about which the commission receives a
- 7 communication under this section an opportunity to respond to the
- 8 communication.
- 9 (d) The governor, the lieutenant governor, or a member of
- 10 the legislature may not communicate with a member of the commission
- 11 under this section about an application that affects a business
- 12 entity in which the governor, lieutenant governor, or member has a
- 13 substantial interest or in which a person related to the governor,
- 14 lieutenant governor, or member within the second degree of
- 15 consanguinity or affinity has a substantial interest, as described
- 16 by Section 572.005, Government Code.
- 17 <u>(e) The commission may establish deadlines for written</u>
- 18 communications described by Subsection (a). A deadline must
- 19 provide the maximum amount of time reasonably possible for
- 20 communication described by Subsection (a).
- 21 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
