- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter E, Chapter 5, Water Code, is amended
- 7 by adding Section 5.180 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 5.180. COMMUNICATIONS WITH CERTAIN GOVERNMENT
- 9 OFFICIALS. (a) In this section, "communicate" means a statement,
- 10 correspondence, or any other form of oral, written, or electronic
- 11 communication.

- 12 (b) Notwithstanding any other law, the governor, the
- 13 lieutenant governor, or a member of the legislature may communicate
- 14 with a commission official or employee concerning any matter before
- 15 the commission. A commission official or employee who receives a
- 16 communication under this section is not required to be recused from
- 17 the matter discussed in the communication.
- (c) The commission official or employee shall receive a
- 19 <u>communication described by Subsection (b).</u>
- 20 <u>(d) If the commission receives written communication</u>
- 21 described by Subsection (b), the commission shall include in the
- 22 record of the matter before the commission a copy of the written
- 23 communication.
- (e) If the commission receives a communication described by

- 1 Subsection (b), the commission shall provide for any party subject
- 2 to the matter discussed in the communication an opportunity to
- 3 respond to the communication.
- 4 (f) An individual may not communicate with a commission
- 5 official or employee under Subsection (b) concerning a matter that
- 6 affects a business entity in which the individual has a substantial
- 7 interest or in which a person related to the individual within the
- 8 first degree of consanguinity has a substantial interest, as
- 9 determined by Section 572.005, Government Code.
- 10 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
