1 SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

2 WHEREAS, Human beings are born male or female, with such
3 biological identity being immutable and innate; and

4 WHEREAS, Even in our great state, ideologues put forth a
5 false narrative that denies this fundamental truth, using lawfare,
6 coercion, and fear to deny women the rights and protections to which
7 they are entitled; and

8 WHEREAS, Across the country, such falsehoods have allowed men
9 to self-identify as women and enter spaces designed for the
10 protection of women, such as women's shelters and women's
11 bathrooms; and

12 WHEREAS, Sex is an immutable characteristic that can be
13 readily identified, and attacks on the definition of sex are
14 baseless; now, therefore, be it

15 RESOLVED, By the 89th Legislature of the State of Texas, That
16 it is the policy of the state to recognize two sexes, male and
17 female; and, be it further

18 RESOLVED, That the State of Texas will defend women's rights
19 by using clear and accurate language and policies recognizing that
20 women are biologically female and men are biologically male.
