1 SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

- WHEREAS, Human beings are born male or female, with such
- 3 biological identity being immutable and innate; and
- WHEREAS, Even in our great state, ideologues put forth a
- 5 false narrative that denies this fundamental truth, using lawfare,
- 6 coercion, and fear to deny women the rights and protections to which
- 7 they are entitled; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Across the country, such falsehoods have allowed men
- 9 to self-identify as women and enter spaces designed for the
- 10 protection of women, such as women's shelters and women's
- 11 bathrooms; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Sex is an immutable characteristic that can be
- 13 readily identified, and attacks on the definition of sex are
- 14 baseless; now, therefore, be it
- RESOLVED, By the 89th Legislature of the State of Texas, That
- 16 it is the policy of the state to recognize two sexes, male and
- 17 female; and, be it further
- 18 RESOLVED, That the State of Texas will defend women's rights
- 19 by using clear and accurate language and policies recognizing that
- 20 women are biologically female and men are biologically male.
