A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment authorizing a statewide
- 2 referendum allowing voters to indicate a preference for observing
- 3 standard time year-round or observing daylight saving time
- 4 year-round.
- 5 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Article XVI, Texas Constitution, is amended by
- 7 adding Section 74 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 74. (a) The legislature by general law may:
- 9 (1) hold a statewide referendum that allows the voters
- 10 to indicate a preference for either:
- 11 (A) observing standard time year-round; or
- 12 (B) observing daylight saving time year-round;
- 13 and
- 14 (2) enact a law based on the results of the referendum
- 15 providing for observing standard time year-round or observing
- 16 daylight saving time year-round.
- 17 (b) A statewide referendum described by Subsection (a) of
- 18 this section that is held on the same day as the election on the
- 19 constitutional amendment to add this section to this article is
- 20 <u>hereby validated.</u>
- 21 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 22 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 4, 2025.
- 23 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
- 24 proposition: "The constitutional amendment authorizing the state

- 1 to conduct a statewide referendum to allow the voters to choose
- 2 between observing standard time year-round and observing daylight
- 3 saving time year-round and authorizing the legislature to enact
- 4 legislation that gives effect to the option preferred by a majority
- 5 of the voters voting in the statewide referendum."
