A JOINT RESOLUTION

proposing a constitutional amendment authorizing certain persons
 under the age of 18 to vote in a primary election.

3 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

4 SECTION 1. Article VI, Texas Constitution, is amended by 5 adding Section 1a to read as follows:

Sec. 1a. The legislature by general law may provide for
voting in a primary election by a person who:

8 (1) will be 18 years of age or older on the date of the 9 subsequent general election for state and county officers; and

10 (2) satisfies the other applicable requirements for 11 eligibility to vote.

12 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be 13 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 4, 2025. 14 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the 15 proposition: "The constitutional amendment authorizing a person 16 who will be 18 years of age or older on the date of the general 17 election for state and county officers to vote in the preceding 18 primary election."
