# RESOLUTION

1 WHEREAS, Sexual Assault Survivors Day is being held at the  
2 State Capitol on January 28, 2025, to promote awareness of the issue  
3 of sexual assault and to honor the courage of survivors throughout  
4 the Lone Star State; and

5 WHEREAS, Each year, thousands of Americans from all walks of  
6 life are subject to sexual assault; in the United States, 1 in 6  
7 women and 1 in 33 men will experience an attempted or completed rape  
8 in their lifetime, and 1 in 9 girls and 1 in 20 boys experience  
9 sexual abuse or assault before the age of 18; more than two-thirds  
10 of sexual assaults are never reported to the police; and

11 WHEREAS, In 2019, the Texas Legislature established Sexual  
12 Assault Survivors Day to bring attention to the destructive effect  
13 that sexual assault has on the lives of survivors and their families  
14 and friends; moreover, the day serves to highlight the strength of  
15 survivors, who support the cause by bravely sharing their stories,  
16 as well as the many law enforcement officers, prosecutors, judges,  
17 and organizations that fight to protect Texans from sexual assault  
18 and to advocate for survivors of this heinous crime; and

19 WHEREAS, Vigilance against sexual assault is crucial to the  
20 safety and well-being of Texans, and the observance of Sexual  
21 Assault Survivors Day offers an opportunity to learn more about  
22 prevention while saluting those who work every day to eliminate  
23 this crime; now, therefore, be it
