R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, Representatives of the Texas Coalition to Prevent  
2 Gun Violence are gathering in Austin on February 27, 2025, to  
3 observe Texas Majority to End Gun Violence Advocacy Day at the State  
4 Capitol; and

5 WHEREAS, The Texas Coalition to Prevent Gun Violence is an  
6 alliance of organizations and experts working to prevent and reduce  
7 gun violence through education, training, and mobilization; the  
8 group also advocates for policies related to mental health,  
9 domestic abuse, and other issues that impact local communities; and

10 WHEREAS, The coalition is supported by Texas Gun Sense, a  
11 nonprofit that champions common-sense, evidence-based solutions  
12 for reducing gun-related injuries and deaths; the organization  
13 seeks to educate the public on effective ways to secure guns in  
14 order to reduce crime and personal injury, as well as raise  
15 awareness about suicide prevention and the safe storage of  
16 firearms; in addition, TGS serves as a resource for information  
17 about federal, state, and local gun policies; and
