2 nursing organizations are gathering in Austin on March 4, 2025, for
3 Nurse Day at the State Capitol; and

4 WHEREAS, Certified nursing assistants, licensed vocational
5 nurses, registered nurses, and advanced practice registered nurses
6 care for Texans each day in hospitals, nursing homes, home health
7 agencies, and other settings; registered nurses constitute the
8 largest health care profession in the state, and they help to ensure
9 that Texans have access to quality health care at all stages of
