RESOLUTION

- 1 WHEREAS, The Senate of the State of Texas joins the residents
- 2 of Ellis County in celebrating March 19, 2025, as Ellis County Day
- 3 at the Texas Capitol; and
- WHEREAS, A county of rural charm and natural beauty, Ellis
- 5 County is located in North Central Texas and was created in 1849
- 6 from Robertson and Navarro Counties; and
- 7 WHEREAS, The county was named for Richard Ellis, who was
- 8 president of the Convention of 1836, which declared Texas'
- 9 independence from Mexico; and
- 10 WHEREAS, During the early days, the land in Ellis County
- 11 served as the buffalo hunting grounds for several tribes; the
- 12 earliest inhabitants and hunters were the Tonkawa, Kickapoo, Bidai,
- 13 Anadarko, and Waco; and
- 14 WHEREAS, Although the early settlers were chiefly stock
- 15 raisers, the land has been cultivated since its first settlement in
- 16 1843, and the county remains a vibrant agricultural area; and
- 17 WHEREAS, The fertile Blackland soils extend through the
- 18 center of the county, and the terrain varies from gently rolling
- 19 hills to level plain; on the east border are the Trinity River and
- 20 Chambers Creek; and
- 21 WHEREAS, The county's farming resources are diverse, with
- 22 livestock, cotton, grains, and other crops contributing to its
- 23 economic stability; and
- 24 WHEREAS, The county seat is Waxahachie, a city which derives

- 1 its name from a Native American word for "cow or buffalo creek" and
- 2 was originally a part of the Chisholm Trail; and
- 3 WHEREAS, This historic town has been the location of several
- 4 major films and is well known for its charming Victorian style homes
- 5 with gingerbread trim; and
- 6 WHEREAS, The Ellis County courthouse in Waxahachie is
- 7 elaborate; it was constructed with granite from Burnet County and
- 8 red sandstone; Italian artisans were imported to carve the
- 9 extensive stone exterior; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Ennis, situated in the eastern part of the county,
- 11 was designated the Bluebonnet City of Texas by the Texas
- 12 Legislature in 1997; a cultural center for descendants of Czech
- 13 farmers who first settled on the Blackland Prairie in 1875, Ennis is
- 14 the site of the National Polka Festival, as well as the Texas
- 15 Motorplex, a professional and amateur track that offers world-class
- 16 auto racing; and
- 17 WHEREAS, The other charming towns of Ellis County balance the
- 18 comfort of small-town life with convenient access to downtown
- 19 Dallas and the Dallas Fort Worth International Airport; and
- WHEREAS, The county is host to numerous festive events,
- 21 including the Scarborough Renaissance Festival, Bethlehem
- 22 Revisited, and the Ennis Bluebonnet Trails and Festival; and
- 23 WHEREAS, Residents of Ellis County have preserved the natural
- 24 beauty of the land and are hospitable and friendly, making Ellis
- 25 County a pleasurable place to live and visit; now, therefore, be it

- 27 Legislature, hereby express appreciation to the people of Ellis
