R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, Civic-minded women from across the Lone Star State
2 are gathering in Austin on March 20 and 21, 2025, to celebrate Texas
3 Federation of Republican Women Days at the State Capitol; and

4 WHEREAS, The Texas Federation of Republican Women was
5 established in San Antonio in October 1955; with more than 300
6 delegates present, the organizing convention was led by
7 Mrs. Malcolm Milburn, and it resulted in the election of Mrs. R. D.
8 O'Callaghan as the first president; in the nearly seven decades
9 since its inception, the organization has grown into one of the
10 largest women's political groups in the country; and

11 WHEREAS, With the goals of educating the electorate,
12 encouraging women to run for office, and electing Republican
13 candidates, TFRW issues informative communications and works
14 closely with other Republican organizations to train volunteers and
15 provide support for local and statewide campaigns through voter
16 registration and outreach activities, political rallies, forums,
17 and legislative day events; and

18 WHEREAS, This notable organization embodies a spirit of
19 public engagement, and its members may reflect with great pride on
20 the exemplary model of citizenship they have set for their fellow
21 Texans; now, therefore, be it

22 RESOLVED, That the Senate of the 89th Texas Legislature
23 hereby recognize March 20 and 21, 2025, as Texas Federation of
24 Republican Women Days at the State Capitol and extend a warm welcome
