19 worked for more than three decades as an environmental consultant,  
20 most recently as the manager of client development services and  
21 environmental services for Terracon Consultants, Inc.; and

22       WHEREAS, Through his dedication, expertise, and leadership,  
23 Walter Miller has greatly benefited the citizens of Horizon City,  
24 and he may indeed reflect with pride on a job well done as he embarks
