## RESOLUTION

8 Senate Rule 12.03(2) is suspended to permit the committee to 9 omit text not in disagreement in proposed SECTION 2 of the bill, by 10 omitting added Section 109.61(a-1)(1)(A)(i), Alcoholic Beverage 11 Code. The omitted text reads:

Explanation: The change is necessary to require the holder of 13 14 store permit to visually inspect а package and access electronically readable information on 15 a driver's license, 16 commercial driver's license, or other identification certificate for the purpose of verifying a purchaser's age in the retail sale of 17 an alcoholic beverage on the premises of the package store for 18 19 off-premises consumption.
