4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 51.803, Education Code, is amended by

6 adding Subsection (c) to read as follows:

7 (c) A general academic teaching institution is not required

8 to fill more than 50 percent of the institution's total number of

spaces available for first-time resident undergraduate students at

the institution through the admission of applicants under

11 <u>Subsection (a). If the number of applications for admission under</u>

Subsection (a) received by the institution exceeds 50 percent of

the total number of spaces available for first-time resident

undergraduate students at the institution, the institution may give

automatic admission as provided by this section to those applicants

until 50 percent of the institution's total number of spaces

17 available for first-time resident undergraduate students are

18 <u>filled</u>. The institution shall consider the factors listed in

21 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
