## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

1-10 relating to returning to a fund outside the state treasury cash that 1-11 was transferred from the fund to the general revenue fund and to the 1-12 transfer of certain payments from the foundation school fund from August of a state fiscal year to September of the following fiscal 1-13 1**-**14 1**-**15 year; making an appropriation.

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> BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: SECTION 1. For the fiscal biennium beginning September 1,

1-16 2003, the comptroller is appropriated from the general revenue fund 1-17 1-18 the amount needed to return any available cash that was transferred 1-19 1-20 to that fund from a fund outside the state treasury and to maintain the equity of the fund from which the transfer was made, as required 1-21 by Section 403.092, Government Code, as amended by Section 19, H.B. 1-22 No. 2425, Acts of the 78th Legislature, Regular Session, 2003.

SECTION 2. Not more than \$5,000,000 of the appropriation made by Section 1 of this Act may be used to allocate earned interest to a fund outside the state treasury under Section 1-23 1-24 1-25 1-26 403.092(a), Government Code.

SECTION 3. During the state fiscal biennium beginning September 1, 2003, the comptroller shall return available cash that 1-27 1-28 1-29 1-30 has been transferred from a fund outside the state treasury to a fund within the state treasury under Section 403.092(a), Government Code, together with the earned interest on the transferred amount, 1-31 1-32 to the fund from which the available cash was transferred within 14 1-33 days after the date on which the available cash was transferred.

SECTION 4. The changes made to Section 42.259, Education Code, by Section 4, H.B. No. 2425, Acts of the 78th Legislature, Regular Session, 2003, and Section 35, H.B. No. 3459, Acts of the 1-34 1-35 1-36 78th Legislature, Regular Session, 2003, effectively transferring 1-37 1-38 certain payments to school districts from August of a state fiscal year to September of the following fiscal year, apply only to a payment from the foundation school fund that is made on or after 1-39 1-40 January 1, 2004. A payment to a school district from the foundation 1-41 school fund that is made before that date is governed by Section 42.259, Education Code, as it existed on June 1, 2003, and the 1-42 1-43 1-44 former law is continued in effect for that purpose.

SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 1-45 1-46 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 1-47 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this Act takes effect on the 91st day after the last day of the 1-48 1-49 legislative session. 1-50

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
