A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to appropriating the amounts deposited to the credit of 3 the dry cleaning facility release fund created by House Bill No. 4 1366, Acts of the 78th Legislature, Regular Session, 2003, to the 5 Texas Commission on Environmental Quality.

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BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. (a) All amounts deposited during the state 7 fiscal biennium beginning September 1, 2003, to the credit of the 8 dry cleaning facility release fund created by Chapter 374, Health 9 and Safety Code, as added by House Bill No. 1366, Acts of the 78th 10 Legislature, Regular Session, 2003, are appropriated to the Texas 11 12 Commission on Environmental Quality for the state fiscal biennium 13 beginning September 1, 2003, for the purpose of administering 14 Chapter 374, subject to the limitations prescribed by Chapter 374 15 or otherwise prescribed by House Bill No. 1366.

Any increase in state employee benefit costs incurred 16 (b) during the state fiscal biennium beginning September 1, 2003, in 17 connection with administering Chapter 374, Health and Safety Code, 18 as added by House Bill No. 1366, Acts of the 78th Legislature, 19 Regular Session, 2003, shall be paid out of the appropriations made 20 by Subsection (a) of this section and shall be allocated to the 21 22 appropriate employee benefit appropriation items in accordance 23 with applicable rules of the comptroller.

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SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003, if it
