## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 7 SECTION 1. (a) All amounts deposited during the state
- 8 fiscal biennium beginning September 1, 2003, to the credit of the
- 9 dry cleaning facility release fund created by Chapter 374, Health
- and Safety Code, as added by House Bill No. 1366, Acts of the 78th
- 11 Legislature, Regular Session, 2003, are appropriated to the Texas
- 12 Commission on Environmental Quality for the state fiscal biennium
- 13 beginning September 1, 2003, for the purpose of administering
- 14 Chapter 374, subject to the limitations prescribed by Chapter 374
- or otherwise prescribed by House Bill No. 1366.
- 16 (b) Any increase in state employee benefit costs incurred
- during the state fiscal biennium beginning September 1, 2003, in
- 18 connection with administering Chapter 374, Health and Safety Code,
- 19 as added by House Bill No. 1366, Acts of the 78th Legislature,
