1-7 AN ACT

1-8 relating to appropriating the amounts deposited to the credit of
1-9 the dry cleaning facility release fund created by House Bill No.
1-10 1366, Acts of the 78th Legislature, Regular Session, 2003, to the
1-11 Texas Commission on Environmental Quality.

1-12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-13 SECTION 1. (a) All amounts deposited during the state
1-14 fiscal biennium beginning September 1, 2003, to the credit of the
1-15 dry cleaning facility release fund created by Chapter 374, Health
1-16 and Safety Code, as added by House Bill No. 1366, Acts of the 78th
1-17 Legislature, Regular Session, 2003, are appropriated to the Texas
1-18 Commission on Environmental Quality for the state fiscal biennium
1-19 beginning September 1, 2003, for the purpose of administering
1-20 Chapter 374, subject to the limitations prescribed by Chapter 374
1-21 or otherwise prescribed by House Bill No. 1366.

1-22 (b) Any increase in state employee benefit costs incurred
1-23 during the state fiscal biennium beginning September 1, 2003, in
1-24 connection with administering Chapter 374, Health and Safety Code,
1-25 as added by House Bill No. 1366, Acts of the 78th Legislature,
1-26 Regular Session, 2003, shall be paid out of the appropriations made
1-27 by Subsection (a) of this section and shall be allocated to the
1-28 appropriate employee benefit appropriation items in accordance
1-29 with applicable rules of the comptroller.

1-30 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003, if it
1-31 receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each
1-32 house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution.
1-33 If this Act does not receive the vote necessary to take effect on
1-34 that date, this Act takes effect November 1, 2003.
