- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 651, Government Code, is amended by 6 adding Section 651.010 to read as follows:
- Sec. 651.010. APPOINTMENT OF PRESIDING OFFICERS BY

 8 GOVERNOR. (a) In this section, "state agency" means a department,

 9 commission, board, office, council, authority, or other agency in

 10 the executive branch of state government that is created by the

 11 constitution or a statute of this state, including:
- (1) a university system or institution of higher
 education as defined by Section 61.003, Education Code; and
- (2) a river authority as defined by Section 30.003,

 Water Code.
- 16 (b) Notwithstanding other law, the governor may designate a
 17 member of the governing body of each state agency as the presiding
 18 officer of that governing body to serve in that capacity at the
 19 pleasure of the governor.
- 20 <u>(c) This section does not apply to a state agency that is</u>
 21 <u>headed by one or more statewide-elected officials or to an entity</u>
 22 <u>that advises or reports to a state agency headed by one or more</u>
 23 statewide-elected officials.
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect November 1, 2003.
