- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 31.022(a), Insurance Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 (a) The governor, with the advice and consent of the senate,
- 8 shall appoint the commissioner. The commissioner serves a <u>one-year</u>
- 9 [two-year] term that expires on February 1 [of each odd-numbered
- 10 **year**].
- 11 SECTION 2. Section 31.023, Insurance Code, is amended to read
- 12 as follows:
- 13 Sec. 31.023. QUALIFICATIONS. The commissioner must:
- 14 (1) be a competent and experienced administrator;
- 15 (2) be well informed and qualified in the fields
- 16 [field] of insurance and insurance regulation; and
- 17 (3) have [at least 10 years of] experience [as an
- 18 executive] in the administration of business or government [or as a
- 19 practicing attorney or certified public accountant, with at least
- 20 five years of that experience in the field of insurance or insurance
- 21 regulation].
- 22 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect November 1, 2003.
