5	SECTION 1. Subtitle A, Title 8, Government Code, is amended
6	by adding Chapter 806 to read as follows:
7	CHAPTER 806. RETIREMENT SYSTEM OVERSIGHT BOARD
8	Sec. 806.001. DEFINITIONS. In this chapter:
9	(1) "Oversight board" means the retirement system
10	oversight board.
11	(2) "State retirement system" means the Employees
12	Retirement System of Texas, the Judicial Retirement System of Texas
13	Plan One, the Judicial Retirement System of Texas Plan Two, and the
14	Teacher Retirement System of Texas. The term does not include the
15	optional retirement program governed by Chapter 830.
16	Sec. 806.002. COMPOSITION OF BOARD; OFFICERS; MEETINGS.
17	(a) The oversight board is composed of five members as described by
18	this section.
19	(b) The governor, the lieutenant governor, the speaker of
20	the house of representatives, the comptroller, and the attorney

- 5 Sec. 806.003. OVERSIGHT BOARD DUTIES. (a) The oversight
- 6 board shall monitor the management of state retirement system
- 7 assets to ensure that each state retirement system is managing its
- 8 assets in accordance with applicable constitutional and statutory
- 9 provisions and applicable actuarial and investment principles.
- 10 (b) An employee, officer, or member of the board of trustees
- of a state retirement system shall provide to a member of the
- 12 oversight board any information, other than information that is
- 13 confidential under other law, that the oversight board member
- 14 requests to carry out the oversight board's duties under this
- 15 <u>section</u>.
- 16 (c) An oversight board member may attend any regular,
- 17 special, or called meeting of the board of trustees of a state
- 18 retirement system to carry out the oversight board's duties under
- 19 this section.
- Sec. 806.004. REIMBURSEMENT FOR EXPENSES. An oversight
- 21 board member may not receive compensation for service on the
- 22 oversight board but is entitled to reimbursement of travel expenses
- 23 that the member incurs while conducting the business of the
- oversight board, as provided by the General Appropriations Act.
- 25 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect November 1, 2003.
