A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to appropriating the fees relating to the office of  
3 patient protection collected by certain licensing agencies for the  
4 Health Professions Council under House Bill No. 2985, Acts of the  
5 78th Legislature, Regular Session, 2003.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

7 SECTION 1. (a) All fees collected during the state fiscal  
8 biennium beginning September 1, 2003, authorized by Subchapter G,  
9 Chapter 101, Occupations Code, as added by House Bill No. 2985, Acts  
10 of the 78th Legislature, Regular Session, 2003, are appropriated to  
11 the Health Professions Council for the state fiscal biennium  
12 beginning September 1, 2003, for the administration of the office  
13 of patient protection under Subchapter G, Chapter 101, Occupations  
14 Code.

15 (b) Any increase in state employee benefit costs incurred  
16 during the state fiscal biennium beginning September 1, 2003, in  
17 connection with administering Subchapter G, Chapter 101,  
18 Occupations Code, as added by House Bill No. 2985, Acts of the 78th  
19 Legislature, Regular Session, 2003, shall be paid out of the  
20 appropriations made by Subsection (a) of this section and shall be  
21 allocated to the appropriate employee benefit appropriation items  
22 in accordance with applicable rules of the comptroller.

23 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives  
24 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

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1 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this  
2 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this  
3 Act takes effect November 1, 2003.
