Section 1701.253, Occupations Code, is amended 6 7 by adding Subsection (j) to read as follows: 8 (j) As part of the minimum curriculum requirements, the 9 commission shall establish a statewide comprehensive education and training program on the proper methods and procedures necessary to 10 11 ensure that a foreign national arrested in this state is given the 12 opportunity to communicate with an official from the consulate of the foreign national's country as soon as is practicable after the 13 foreign national's arrest. 14 SECTION 2. (a) The Commission on Law Enforcement Officer 15 Standards and Education shall establish the curriculum for a

16 Standards and Education shall establish the curriculum for a 17 comprehensive education and training program for peace officers as 18 required by Section 1701.253(j), Occupations Code, as added by this 19 Act, on or before March 1, 2004.

(b) For persons who are licensed peace officers on November
1, 2003, the first course required under Section 1701.253(j),
Occupations Code, as added by this Act, must be completed before
November 1, 2005.
