- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 111.006(a), Tax Code, is amended to read
- 6 as follows:
- 7 (a) The following matter is confidential and may not be used
- 8 publicly, opened to public inspection, or disclosed except as
- 9 permitted by this section:
- 10 (1) a federal tax return or federal tax return
- information required to have been submitted to the comptroller with
- 12 a state tax return or report; [and]
- 13 (2) all information secured, derived, or obtained by
- 14 the comptroller or the attorney general during the course of an
- examination of the taxpayer's books, records, papers, officers, or
- 16 employees, including an examination of the business affairs,
- operations, source of income, profits, losses, or expenditures of
- 18 the taxpayer; and
- 19 (3) the name or other identifying information of a
- 20 taxpayer whose records are selected for examination by the
- 21 comptroller until the date the comptroller:
- 22 (A) issues a determination under Section 111.008
- 23 or 111.022; or
- 24 (B) credits an amount or issues a refund to the

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- 1 <u>taxpayer under Section 111.104</u>.
- 2 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect November 1, 2003.
