

HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

1 WHEREAS, The year 2003 marks the conclusion of a
2 distinguished career in community economic development for Marvin
3 L. Wynn, who is retiring as president and CEO of the Midland Chamber
4 of Commerce after nearly a decade of dedicated service in that
5 position; and

6 WHEREAS, Mr. Wynn earned a bachelor's degree in accounting
7 and economics from Mississippi College in Clinton, Mississippi, and
8 went on to attend the Economic Development Institute at the
9 University of Oklahoma; in 1971, he was designated a certified
10 economic developer by the American Economic Development Council;

12 WHEREAS, This esteemed gentleman began his career as the vice
13 president of economic development at the Metropolitan Tulsa Chamber
14 of Commerce, and over the ensuing years he served as the vice
15 president and general manager of Whiteside and Grant Realtors in
16 Tulsa and as the chief operating officer for Wichita/Sedgwick
17 County Partnership for Growth, Inc.; Mr. Wynn assumed his current
18 post in June of 1994, and he has since won the respect and
19 admiration of his fellow citizens for his vision and dedication;

21 WHEREAS, A natural leader, Mr. Wynn has served as the
22 director or president of the Kansas Industrial Developers
23 Association, the Southern Economic Development Council, the Texas
24 Association of Business and Chambers of Commerce, the Texas Chamber

3 WHEREAS, In all that he does, Mr. Wynn is supported by his
4 talented and lovely wife, Susan Gish Wynn, who has also been a
5 stellar addition to the Midland and West Texas community; and

6 WHEREAS, Marvin Wynn has contributed greatly toward the
7 advancement of the Midland community and the State of Texas, and it
8 is a pleasure to honor him for his outstanding efforts in behalf of
9 the people of the Lone Star State; now, therefore, be it

11 1st Called Session, hereby congratulate Marvin L. Wynn on his
12 retirement from the Midland Chamber of Commerce and extend to him
