1 WHEREAS, Rice Owls first baseman Vincent Sinisi was chosen by
2 the Texas Rangers as the 46th overall draft choice in the 2003 Major
3 League Baseball draft after achieving notable success as a member
4 of the 2003 College World Series championship team; and

5 WHEREAS, Throughout the 2003 season, Mr. Sinisi lit up the
6 diamond with exceptional plays, putting out 616 baserunners while
7 notching 38 assists and 51 double plays; a .338 hitter, he collected
8 97 hits and 10 homers, scored 61 runs, knocked in another 59, and
9 stole 11 bases; and

10 WHEREAS, One of the major contributors to his team's success
11 at the College World Series, Mr. Sinisi will undoubtedly continue
12 to be a source of tremendous pride to the Lone Star State as a member
13 of the Texas Rangers, and as he enters the major leagues, it is most
14 fitting that he be recognized for his accomplishments in collegiate
15 baseball at Rice University; now, therefore, be it

17 Legislature, 1st Called Session, hereby commend Vincent Sinisi for
18 his exemplary athletic achievements and extend to him best wishes
19 for continued success in professional baseball; and, be it further
