6 WHEREAS, Established in 1883, the *Mansfield News-Mirror* was
7 the oldest weekly newspaper in Tarrant County before it adopted its
8 current format as a semiweekly; it has been a part of the Knight
9 Ridder family of publications for three years, and the paper is
10 currently in the hands of a highly capable team that includes
11 publisher Lance Winter, managing editor Brigitte Cummings, sports
12 writer Mario Zavala, Jr., staff writer Mark Wright, advertising
13 manager Michael Eddleman, office manager Sharon Knowles,
14 production manager Daniel DeHart, and production assistant Melissa
15 Englert; and

16 WHEREAS, The *News-Mirror* received top honors for general
17 excellence in the Division 5 category, which includes semiweekly
18 papers with circulation figures of 4,000 or less; the paper also
19 earned first-place finishes for headline writing, photography,
20 page design, and sports coverage, and its notable record of success
21 is a testament to the talent, professionalism, and dedication of
22 the *News-Mirror* staff; and
