1           WHEREAS, The Federation of Asian Voters in Houston marked its  
2 10-year anniversary on July 18, 2003, by welcoming a very  
3 distinguished guest in Mr. Tran Dinh Truong; and

4           WHEREAS, This individual--who sought and secured refuge from  
5 Communist Vietnam not only for himself and his family, but for over  
6 8,300 others as well--became a citizen of the United States and has  
7 given freely of his time and resources for the betterment of  
8 society, including a response to international need by the donation  
9 of 10 helicopters to disaster relief efforts in Africa and an  
10 individual contribution of \$2 million to the local American Red  
11 Cross chapter in New York after the terrorist attacks of September  
12 11, 2001; and

13           WHEREAS, Mr. Tran Dinh Truong is a respected business and  
14 philanthropic leader whose generous efforts are an encouragement to  
15 others to get involved and improve their communities, and he serves  
16 as a much-needed model for civic pride and love of freedom; now,

19 Legislature, 1st Called Session, hereby honor and congratulate Mr.
