5 secured refuge from Communist Vietnam not only for themselves, but  
6 for over 8,300 others as well--became citizens of the United States

9 donation of two helicopters to disaster relief efforts in Africa  
10 and a contribution of \$2 million to the local American Red Cross  
11 chapter in New York after the terrorist attacks of September 11,
