WHEREAS, Throughout the history of this nation, in times of 1 2 great peril, men and women of the United States military have 3 marched bravely into battle to defend our precious liberties; and WHEREAS, First Lieutenant Jonathan David Rozier embarked 4 5 from Fort Riley in support of our nation's campaign to liberate 6 Iraqi citizens from oppression; commanding the 2nd Platoon, Bravo Company, 2-70 Armor, 3rd Brigade Combat Team, 1st Armored Division, 7 he was killed in action on July 19, 2003, when his unit came under 8 enemy attack while guarding a municipal building in Baghdad; and 9 WHEREAS, The beloved husband of Jessica Desiree Rozier and 10 devoted father to their son, Justin, this courageous soldier was 11 12 born in Dallas on July 16, 1978; after being home-schooled through high school, he attended Texas A&M University, where he joined the 13 14 prestigious Corps of Cadets, and graduated in 2001 with a 15 bachelor's degree in economics; and WHEREAS, Commissioned a second lieutenant in the United 16 States Army on December 15, 2001, and promoted to first lieutenant 17 on June 15, 2003, Lieutenant Rozier earned the Bronze Star for Valor 18 in the Battle of Al Hillah, one of only 15 soldiers to receive that 19 honor during Operation Iragi Freedom, and he will receive the 20 21 Purple Heart posthumously; and WHEREAS, Unflinching bravery and a resolute commitment to 22 23 fulfill his oath to serve, regardless of the personal consequences,
