> WHEREAS, An active member of the Waco community, he is the current president of the Chapter 10 Pearl Harbor Survivors Association; he visits local schools and colleges to share his firsthand account of the attack on Pearl Harbor, thereby helping young Texans to remember the human toll taken by that devastating
